

## How to Join the ALPO Jupiter Groups.IO Email Network

The ALPO Jupiter section maintains an email group hosted on **Groups . io** where subscribers are invited to posted messages, observations, and alerts about the planet Jupiter.

You will need to create a Groups . io account to subscribe to the ALPO Jupiter group by visiting <https://groups.io/register> and entering your email address and password. The site also allows you to use your Google or Facebook account if you prefer.

Once you have set up an account you simply need to send an email using the account you registered to [ALPO-JUPITER+subscribe@groups.io](mailto:ALPO-JUPITER+subscribe@groups.io) – that's all there is to it! Once you have joined you can tailor your subscription preferences by accessing the subscription page (for example, you can specify to receive emails for each post to the group or simply receive a daily digest). You can respond to messages from either the [Messages section](#) of the group or directly from your email client.
